Application Instructions

Handling: Paint should be stirred and poured gently. Do not mix mechanically.

Preparation: For best results make note of the following primer suggestions: For Black Aqua Trunk Paint apply a darker primer before painting. For Grey White Trunk Paint apply a lighter primer before painting.

Reduction: None necessary. If thinning is required, water should be added gradually in small increments until an acceptable spray pattern is achieved.

Application Technique: A 2 quart pressure pot is needed for best results, 10-25 lbs pressure, hold gun 10-15 inches away to get correct pattern - pattern will change with distance change from surface.

CleanUp: Flush equipment with water followed by mineral spirits or flush equipment with lacquer thinner.

Precautions: Use with adequate ventilation.

Dry Time: Dry to touch, 2 to 4 hours, to use 24 hours, and full cure is 5 to 7 days. Dry time will vary according to temperature, humidity, and film thickness.

** This trunk paint does not require a clear top coat.
